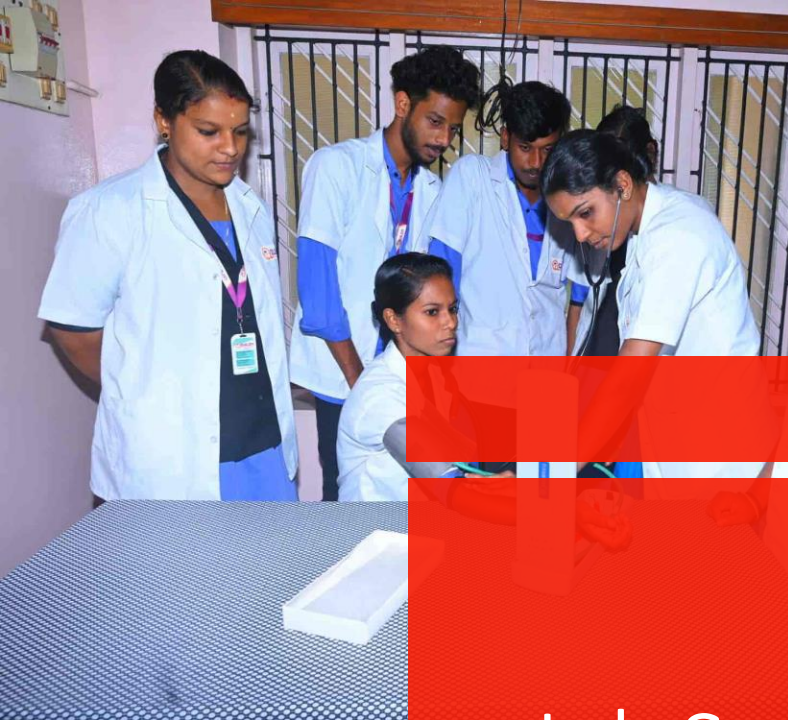

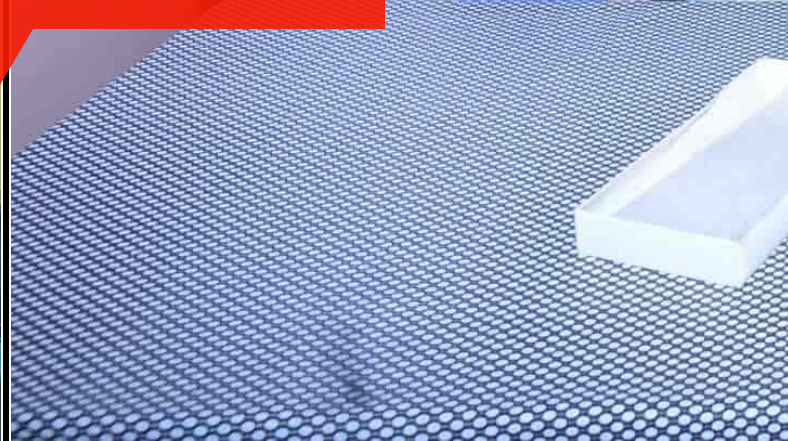
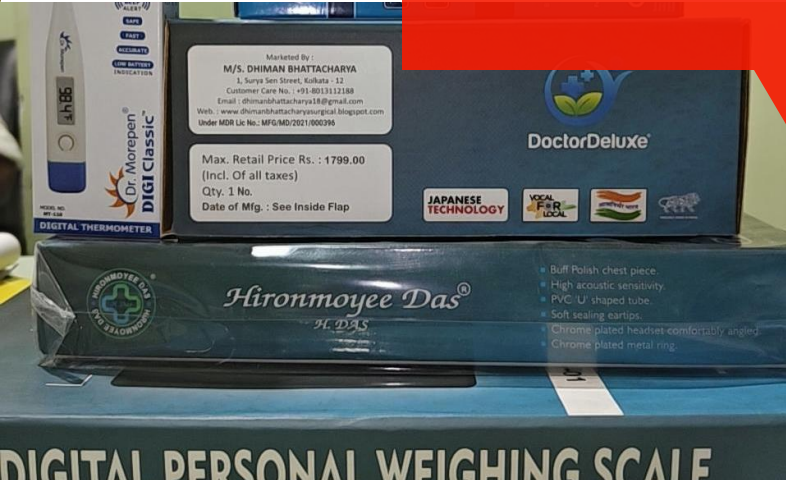

Booth: ₹7,000–₹8,000.

Organizational Hierarchy and Structure

- 1. District Level (DHD) – District Health Director):Monitoring the operations of all blocks under the district.
- 2. Block Level (BHM– Block Health Maneger):Supervising the work of Panchayat-level staff and Health Awareness Associates, and reporting directly to the district authority
- 3.GP level:(GPS- Gram panchayet supervisor):Supervising the work of field workers and reporting to the Block Manager.
- 4. Booth level: (SSM – swastha sachetan Mitra):A grassroots-level key worker who will be directly connected with the general public.



Description of Work

- ⦿ Awareness: Door-to-door visits to educate families on health and provide medical advice.
- ⦿ Services: Using a “Health Insurance Card” to provide free year-round tests including: Blood tests and Sugar tests. Blood pressure monitoring. Cough and Urine tests.
- Final Objective: To ensure year-round primary healthcare services for the general public and safeguard them from serious diseases through continuous health support and awareness.
